Sand supplier extends Seafeld contract

Sibelco UK, which supplies sand, has renewed its contract with Seafeld Logistics for a further three years.

Seafeld will manage the distribution of sand from ten UK quarries operated by Sibelco (formerly WBB Minerals) to customers in the UK.
