As part of its strategy to reduce costs and increase efficiency, Seafield Logistics is setting up a contract maintenance scheme for the majority of its units, trailers and equipment.

The plan, which will be fully operational within the next two years, will see most of Seafield's fleet and equipment put onto a full contract maintenance scheme.

Seafield has appointed a number of contractors to look after its various locations across the UK.

Seafield, which has a base in Guyhirn, still owns some units, tanks, flatbeds and curtainsiders but these are being moved over to a standard contract maintenance scheme.

Gradually the vehicles owned by the company will be phased out and replaced with leased vehicles on full contract maintenance.
